Recruitment of Fellows and Assistant Fellows under MMVAFP for the Government of Arunachal Pradesh

Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Centre for Policy Research & Analysis (Dr. Kalam Centre), IIM Shillong is looking for young, talented, innovative and dynamic professional candidates for the position of 35 Fellows and 65 Assistant Fellows. The Fellows and Assistant Fellows will be engaged by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh under various verticals/divisions/departments.

This program under Mukhya Mantri Viksit Arunachal Fellowship Programme (MMVAFP) for the Government of Arunachal Pradesh seeks to engage Indian students having Graduation from reputed Universities and institutions like IITs/IMs//ISB/TISS who will be given access to the planning and evaluation process within Government of Arunachal Pradesh and would be expected to supplement the activities within the Finance, Planning & Investment.

Purpose: It is designed to provide valuable experience to youth interested in social development sector and to cultivate young leaders, strengthen their understanding of the public administration and prepare them for greater leadership roles in future. To allow short term exposure of selected candidates with the different Verticals/Divisions/Units and planning process in the districts under Finance, Planning & Investment, Government of Arunachal Pradesh as "Fellows" and "Assistant Fellows".

Objectives of the Scheme:

- a) To allow young academic talents to be associated with the Department of Finance, Planning & Investment Department and to work for mutual benefit.
- b) It is an opportunity for young graduates/postgraduates and professionals to work with the State government.

- c) The "Fellows" and "Assistant Fellows" shall have an opportunity to know about the Government functioning and Developmental Policy issues in Government of Arunachal Pradesh and contribute to the Policy formulation by generating policy inputs such as empirical analysis, brief reports, policy papers, etc.
- d. These Fellows and Assistant Fellows will help identify problems in the design of programs, schemes and implementation processes through rigorously structured research projects, so that necessary improvement can be made to the policy implementation levels at implementation level.
- e. It will help the Fellows and Assistant Fellows in their career later. This program provides opportunities for professional growth and learning.

Selection of Fellows and Assistant Fellows will be through written examination and personal interviews purely on merit and based on academic credentials/performances.

Fellows and Assistant Fellows will be required to have their own laptops. GoAP shall provide the working space, internet facility and other necessities as deemed fit by the Department of Finance, Planning and Investment.

Relaxation:

GoAP will have the power to relax any of the conditions except the educational qualification mentioned above in respect of any deserving candidates.

Procedure and conditions for Applicants

- 1. Interested and eligible candidates may apply using the mentioned below.
- 2. The last date for submission of the application is 1700 hrs on 06-07-2025
- 3. Applications received after the due date and time will not be entertained and are liable to be rejected.
- 4. Applicants must specify their area of interest and willingness to take up any tasks during the Contract period.
- 5. The crucial date for the determination of essential qualifications and age limit will be the closing date of application.
- 6. Candidates are requested kindly to go through the advertisement carefully, before applying.
- 7. If the number of applications received in response to the advertisement is large, IIM, Shillong may shortlist the candidates to a reasonable limit based on the essential and desirable qualifications/record of academic performance / relevant experience for the post or any other benchmarks as decided by a committee constituted to screen the applications.
- 8. The prescribed essential qualifications are minimum and mere possession of the same does not entitle candidates to be called for an Interview/Selection.
- 9. Candidates will have to produce the proof of details furnished in their applications, in original, during the Interview.
